



Key Vocabulary

Wild plants

A wild plant seed grows where it falls. It doesn't need to be planted or cared for as it grows. A weed is a wild plant.

Garden plants

Plants that people choose to grow in their garden.

Deciduous trees

A deciduous tree loses its leaves each year.

Evergreen tree

An evergreen tree keeps its green leaves all year round, even in the winter.

Trunk

Holds the tree up and carries water and nutrients from the soil to the leaves and flowers.

Stem

Stem holds the plant up and carries the water and nutrients from the roots to the leaves and flowers.

Leaves

Leaves catch sunlight to make food for the plant.

Flowers

Flowers attract insects and birds.

Petals

Petals are the colourful part of the flower.

Fruit

Fruit contains the plant's seeds.

Roots

Roots take in water and nutrients from the soil.

Seeds and Bulbs grow into new plants.
