**The Five Senses**



**Taste** Your sense of taste comes from your tongue. You can tell if something tastes bitter or sweet.

**Hearing** Your ears let you listen to all the things around you and your brain is able to tell what the different sounds are.

**Touch** Your skin gives you the sense of touch. You can tell if something is warm, cold, smooth, rough, soft or hard.

**Sight** Your eyes let you see all the things around you.

**Smell** You smell using your nose. Your nose can tell if things smell nice or not nice.
