

There are four **seasons**

**Autumn** - September, October, November


**Winter** - December, January, February

**Spring** - March, April, May

**Summer** - June, July, August

## Key Vocabulary

**Seasons** There are 4 seasons each year, autumn, Spring, summer and winter.

**Autumn** In autumn the amount of time it is light becomes less, the leaves start to change colour and fall off the trees.

**Winter** We have colder weather, sometimes snow and frost, the trees have no leaves and the amount of time it is light during the day is at its shortest.

**Spring** The weather turns warmer, trees begin to grow their leaves, plants start to flower and young animals such as chicks and lambs are born.

**Summer** The weather is warm, trees have green leaves and the gardens are full of flowers The amount of time it is light for during the day is longer.

**Daylight** When it is light outside. The number of hours of daylight changes with each season.

**Temperature** A measure of how hot or cold it is.

**Sun** The Sun keeps our planet warm and plants to grow.
