Key Vocabulary

Germination When the conditions are right, the seed soaks up the water and opens. This is called germination.

Shoot A shoot grows upwards from the seed or plant towards the sunlight.

Seed Dispersal When seeds are carried by wind and animals away from the parent plant.

Temperature How hot or cold somewhere or something is.

Nutrition Plants use the sunlight to make their own food (nutrition) in their leaves.

What you should already know...

Plants are a large group of living things that use sunlight to make their own food.

There are many, many different kinds of plants, including trees, vines and grasses.

Plants have lots of different parts, for example stems, leaves and roots.

Some trees lose their leaves in the winter (deciduous). Some keep their leaves through the year (evergreen).

Some plants are 'flowering plants' – they grow flowers on them.
