Jesus' life story:

Gospels tell us what Jesus said and did however there is no description of what he looked like. All images of Jesus are influenced by artists experiences and beliefs, and they were not done until nearly 150 years after his death.



Key Vocabulary

Gospels The teachings of Christ in the Bible.

Incarnation That God becomes one of us in our own place and time, and Jesus was God come to earth as a human.

Inspirational Where someone makes us want to do or achieve something.

Parables A story with a moral, as told by Jesus.

Resurrection The rising of Jesus from the dead.

Good Friday The Friday before Easter, commemorating Jesus's death on the cross.
