Latin uses different noun **endings** to show **subject** and **object**.

- 2 Latin nouns can be split into nouns ending in -a and nouns ending in -us
- Latin also uses different noun endings to show singular (just one) and plural (more than one)

object	am	as

subject	us	ij
object	um	os
